This fee is only charged on tires being shipped to a California address.

SHIPPING

Shipping charges are based on order value unless oversized.

Chaparral® Motorsports' standard shipping time is 2 business days via Ground and 2 Day Air services (Tires and oversized items ship via USPS or UPS Ground). Shipping requires a street address (no P.O. Boxes). Shipping available to USA, APO/FPO, Canada and Puerto Rico only.

Chaparral® customers will receive an email notification of the shipment along with tracking information, if available.

Any duties, taxes and brokerage fees are the customer's responsibility and payable at time of delivery. These fees are over and above the shipping cost charged by Chaparral® Motorsports.

Defective parts or parts sent to you in error will be exchanged or refunded in full.

We suggest that you exchange the item rather than refund the item in order to avoid price changes. EXCEPTIONS

- Orders being shipped to AK, HI, PR are shipped via USPS or UPS 2nd Day.
- Batteries are shipped acid free.

INTERNATIONAL SHIPPING

Chaparral® Motorsports ships via the United States Postal Service to international, APO/FPO, Canadian and Puerto Rican destinations.

EXPEDITED SHIPPING

Air service delivery orders placed before 4:00pm PT will be shipped same day, pending inventory availability.

Next Day Air:

DELIVERY PROCESS

Allow 3-7 business days for delivery of non-backordered items. Delivery during the holiday season may require additional shipping days. Backorder dates are estimated times of arrival for the product to be received at Chaparral® Motorsports. Orders for in-stock merchandise placed before 1pm Pacific Time usually ship the same business day.

Entire order will be shipped together, if possible. However, we do send partial shipments to help get your available in stock merchandise to you as soon as possible.

BASIC BREAK-IN AND MAINTENANCE

When new tires are mounted, they should not be subjected to any of the following until a reasonable run-in distance of approximately 100 miles has been covered:

- Hard Acceleration -Hard Cornering -Hard Braking

This initial break-in period allows the user time to become accustomed to the handling characteristics of the new tire.

TIRE PRESSURE

A frequent check of tire pressures is one of the most important maintenance functions you can perform on your motorcycle or all-terrain vehicle. Underinflated tires can result in poor handling, premature wear, fatigue cracking and/or potential tire pressure failure. Proper recommended air pressures are listed on the manufacturer's plate on all motorcycles, in your owner's manual, or are available from your local dealer. Check cold tire pressure frequently with an approved, quality gauge. Most importantly, visual inspection of tires should be done every time you plan to ride your motorcycle or all-terrain vehicle. Look for foreign objects on the tread surface or low tread depths(via tread wear indicators).

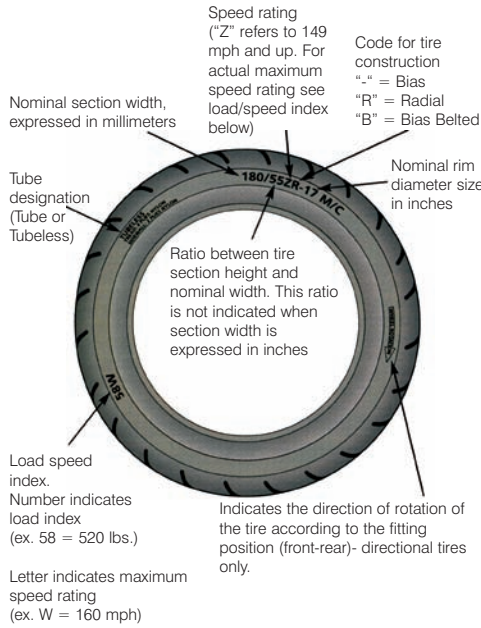

Critical clearances, motorcycle compatibility, load bearing capacity, speed rating, radial versus non-radial, pattern and tread compound requirements, inflation recommendations, and front and rear matching will all vary with tire selection. Wrong selection can result in tire failure, loss of control with serious injury or death.

TIRE SELECTION, SAFETY, CARE, AND MAINTENANCE

When selecting new motorcycle tires, be sure they meet the requirements of your motorcycle and its expected usage.

Fitment of radial tires to the wrong vehicle can cause instability and accident. Some motorcycles may only be fitted with radials. Consult motorcycle manufacturer before fitting radial replacements to ensure you are applying the correct specification and combination for your customer's motorcycle. Some motorcycles may only be fitted with radials that match original equipment.

FRONT AND REAR TIRE MATCHING

Remember, correct matching of front and rear tires is important to obtain optimum performance and handling. Mount only tires marked "front wheel" on front positions and only tires marked "rear wheel" on rear positions. A new front tire on the same motorcycle with a worn rear tire can cause instability. Mixing radials, or mixing radials with bias or belted bias tires, may adversely affect handling and stability.

LOAD CARRYING CAPABILITIES

Never exceed the accessory restrictions and vehicle load capacity found in the motorcycle owner's manual, or the maximum load molded on the tire sidewall.

MAINTAINING CLEARANCE

Adequate clearance of fenders, swingarm, etc., must be maintained. Increasing tire size may require an increase in rim width. When increasing tire size and/or rim width, rotate wheel and inspect closely for sufficient clearance.

TUBES

When fitting a new tire on a rim requiring a tube, a new tube should be fitted at the same time. **Always check the size markings on the tube to assure that the tire size appears on the tube.**

SAFETY TIPS FOR THE OFFROAD MOTORCYCLIST

Always maintain the recommended tire pressure for the type of terrain on which the motorcycle is being ridden; check the owner's manual. Underinflated tires may cause wheel damage when ridden in rocky, rough terrain and allow the motorcycle to squirm or wander on smooth, hard terrains.

Over inflation: Over inflation may damage the tires and cause an unnecessarily harsh ride. To accurately measure tire pressure, use a standard tire pressure gauge.

Condition: Check for cuts and gouges that may cause air leakage. Also check the tires for missing knobs and excessively worn tread.

Wheels: To avoid loss of control or injury, make sure axle nuts are tight and secured. Grasp each tire at the front and rear and try to rock it on its axle to detect worn out bearings or loose nuts. There should be no free play or slip as you rock the wheel. Inspect wheels for broken or loose spokes and for cracks on the hub or rim.
